

THERE IS NO WAY “THE SINNER’S PRAYER” CAN SAVE ANYBODY

Although most of the religious world believes “The Sinner’s Prayer” brings an alien sinner into right standing with God, the Word of God smacks down this false doctrine time and time again. Note the evidence below.

John 6:63

The words Jesus spoke profit to spiritual life.

Jesus never said a word about “The Sinner’s Prayer” (Sometimes hereafter SP).

CONCLUSION: “The Sinner’s Prayer” **CANNOT** profit to spiritual life.

John 8:31

The way one becomes a true disciple of Jesus is through His Word.

“The Sinner’s Prayer” is not part of His Word.

CONCLUSION: “The Sinner’s Prayer” **CANNOT** make one a disciple of Jesus.

John 12:49

The words which our Lord has spoken are of Divine origin.

The Lord never spoke about “The Sinner’s Prayer.”

CONCLUSION: “The Sinner’s Prayer” **IS NOT** of Divine origin.

John 16:13

The Holy Spirit would guide the apostles into all truth.

The Holy Spirit did not reveal “The Sinner’s Prayer” to the apostles.

CONCLUSION: “The Sinner’s Prayer” **IS NOT** part of the truth.

Matthew 6:10

God’s will is to be done in (on) the earth.

The silence of Jesus on the subject teaches us the will of the Father is not “The Sinner’s Prayer.”

CONCLUSION: “The Sinner’s Prayer” **IS NOT** to be done in (on) the earth.

Matthew 7:21

One must do the will of the Father to enter into the KOH.

The silence of Jesus on the subject teaches the will of the Father is not “The SP.”

CONCLUSION: “The Sinner’s Prayer” **WILL NOT** allow one to enter the kingdom of heaven.

Matthew 12:46-50

Only those who do the will of the Father can rightfully claim to be in God’s family.

“The Sinner’s Prayer” is not the will of the Father.

CONCLUSION: Those who offer “The Sinner’s Prayer” **CANNOT** rightfully claim to be in God’s family.

Revelation 22:16-18

The condemnation of God rests upon those who add to His Word.

“The SP” is an addition to the Word of God.

CONCLUSION: Those who pray and/or advocate “The Sinner’s Prayer” have the **CONDEMNATION OF GOD UPON THEM.**

Acts 2:42

The early church followed the apostles’ inspired doctrine.

“The SP” was not something taught by the apostles.

CONCLUSION: “The Sinner’s Prayer” **WAS NOT** something done in the early church.

Colossians 3:17

Everything regarding Christianity must be authorized by Christ.

Christ did not authorize “The SP.”

CONCLUSION: Those who prayed the “Sinner’s Prayer” have done something that **DOES NOT** pertain to Christianity.

2 Timothy 1:13

Paul taught sound words that were to be held to.

“The Sinner’s Prayer” was not something Paul taught.

CONCLUSION: “The Sinner’s Prayer” **IS NOT** something to be held to because it **IS NOT** sound doctrine.

2 Timothy 3:16

Scripture is the inspired Word of God.

Scripture does not mention “The SP.”

CONCLUSION: “The Sinner’s Prayer” **IS NOT** part of inspiration.

2 Timothy 3:16-17

Scripture furnishes man unto every good work.

Scripture does not mention “The SP.”

CONCLUSION: “The Sinner’s Prayer” **IS NOT** a good work.

1 Peter 4:11

If any man speaks he is commanded to do so in conjunction with the oracles of God.

“The Sinner’s Prayer” is not an oracle of God.

CONCLUSION: When one prays “The SP” **HE IS BREAKING A COMMANDMENT OF GOD.**

2 Peter 1:3

God has given man, in His Word, all we need to know for life and godliness.

“The SP” is not mentioned in the Word of God.

CONCLUSION: “The Sinner’s Prayer” **DOES NOT** pertain to either life or godliness.

1 John 5:14

Men must pray in connection with God’s will.

“The SP” is not the will of God.

CONCLUSION: Those who lift “The SP” do so **AGAINST THE WILL OF GOD.**
